

OBITUARY!

The death of Philo Macoy was announced yesterday, he having passed away in the early morning. He contracted a severe cold while out riding a few days before his death.

Uremia set in and he was unconscious most of the time.

The funeral occurred Thursday, August 1st, at the residence of A. D. Williams four miles south of Hope, and the interment at the Hope cemetery.

The deceased was an honored resident of the community, aged 79 years, 3 months and 6 days.

Philo Macoy was born in the state of Vermont May 4, 1818, and was married to Miss G. L. Kendell in 1842.

They moved to Fond du Lac, Wis., in 1853, which has since been their home.
