

Hit by Freight Train.

Lars Sund and Miss Bugjerde, while trying to cross the railroad at the Dronen crossing, three and a half miles northwest of Finley, about noon today were struck by the engine of a south-bound freight. Both horses were killed, the buggy demolished, and both occupants injured. Mr. Sund was cut considerably about the head and somewhat bruised, while the lady was bruised some, and may have suffered internal injuries.

It is said the engine did not whistle for the crossing, and being bundled up, and the side curtains on the buggy, Mr. Sund did not see or hear the train until they were struck. The train did not stop until it reached Finley, and the crew made no report of an accident to the agent here. It does not seem possible that the enginemen were ignorant of the accident.—Finley Bacon.
