Monday, Wednesday and Fridays the mail will be carried east and south and Tuesday, Thursday and Saturdays it will go west and south. We are informed that the routes are about twenty-six miles in length and will deliver mail to about one hundred families on each route. J. P. Barling has been appointed carrier. Regular postage is required on all letters delivered by the carrier. Don't fail to put a two cent stamp on your letters.
