

# Open Season.

DATES ON WHICH DIFFERENT GAME BIRDS AND ANIMALS CAN BE KILLED.

The following will be of interest to the local nimrods:

The chicken season opens Sept 1 and closes Oct. 15.

Buffalo, moose, elk, caribou, mountain sheep—absolutely protected at all times.

Antelope protected until Jan. 1, 1911.

Deer—Nov. 10 to Dec. 1.

Beaver, protected until Jan. 1, 1920.

Otter, Nov. 10 to Dec. 10.

Quail, English and Chinese

Sept. 1

any one person; hook and line only allowed.

Unlawful to kill more than 25 game birds above mentioned in any one day, or more than five of the animals mentioned in any one season.

Unlawful to sell, expose for sale or have in possession with intent to sell or ship for sale any prairie chicken, pinnated, sharp-tailed or ruffled grouse, woodcock or deer.

Shipments of any and all game without the state prohibited.

Unlawful to hunt without a license.

Resident license, 75 cents.

Non-resident license \$25.
