Ellingson were appointed a committee draw up and present a petition to the school board, to call a special meeting of the voters to vote on the bonding of the district for \$4000 to build and equip a new school house, to be ready for occupancy next fall. The matter of a new school house is one that every citizen should be interested in, and should the petition be adequately signed and go through, all should turn out and vote on the question, according to the best interests of the school.
