

Official Proceedings

Of the Board of County Commissioners.

Sherbrooke, N. Dak. Oct. 3rd, 1905.

The Board of County Commissioners reconvened at 9 o'clock A. M. pursuant to adjournment, all members present.

Minutes of the meeting of October 2nd, 1905 read and on motion approved. The committee appointed to inspect site for grading on line between sections 27-28 and 21-22 Finley twp. made their report, recommending that an appropriation of not to exceed \$250.00 be made; said money to be paid when work is done to the satisfaction of the township board of Finley twp. On motion the report was accepted, approved and committees discharged.

The bridge on line between sections 27 and 34 Enger township having been rebuilt in a satisfactory manner and according to contract, the auditor was on motion ordered to draw warrant in favor of the Northwestern Bridge Co. for the amount of \$535.00 balance due on bridge contract. The following bridge and grade petitions were presented:

Petition to replank bridge on line between section 8 and 9 Primrose twp.

Petition for a bridge to be built on line between sections 12 and 13 Broadlawn twp.

Petition for an appropriation of \$400.00 for grading and establishing a road on line between sections 13 and 14 and 23-24 Franklin twp.

Petition for new bridge on line between section 1 Edendale and section 36 Primrose twps.

Petition for new bridge on line between sections 24 and 25 Primrose twp.

On motion the following petitions were taken from the table:

Petition for a bridge and an appropriation of \$500.00 for grading on line between sections 15 and 16 Easton twp.

Petition for a bridge on line between sections 26 and 35 Newburgh.

Petition for a bridge across the middle branch of the Goose river on line between section 3 and 10 Primrose twp.

Petition for bridge and an appropriation of \$125.00 for grading on lines between section 3 Colgate twp. and section 35 and 36 Hugo twp.

Petition for a bridge on line between sections 3 and 10 Enger twp.

Petition for a bridge on line between sections 17 and 18 Golden Lake.

Petition for an appropriation of \$200.00 to rebuild bridge on line between sections 17 and 20 Westfield twp.

Motion made, seconded and carried that the chairman appoint a committee of all the members of the Board to inspect bridge and grade sites as per petitions.

On motion adjournment was taken till 1:30 P. M. same day.

AFTERNOON SESSION.

The Board of County Commissioners reconvened at 1:30 P. M. all members present.

The Register of Deeds monthly statements of fees collected for quarter ending Sept 30th, 1905, amounting to \$336.65, was on motion approved and ordered filed.

The Clerk of Court monthly statements of fees collected for quarter ending Sept. 30th 1905, amounting to \$297.05, was on motion approved and ordered filed.

On motion duly seconded and carried, G. O. Johnson was appointed as appraiser to appraise stray horses taken up June 23rd, 1904 by Curry Bros. of Franklin twp.

The Coroner's report in the matter of an inquisition held at Finley upon the dead body of Jacob Greenfield, was on motion approved.

The Justice reports of R. J. Still and C. G. Boise for quarter ending Sept. 30th, 1905, also Board of Health bills were on motion laid on the table awaiting approval and advice of the States Attorney.
