Official Proceedings of the Board of County Commissioners' Of Steele County.

Sherbrooke, N. D., Aug. 27th 1904.

The board of County Commissioners convened at 1:30 o'clock P. M. pursuant to call of County Auditor. Present, G. O. Johnson, F. Gray, O. E. Elliott and K. S. Sulland. Minutes of the meeting of July 11th 1904 read and on motion approved. A requisition was received from the Clerk of the District Court for 40 Jurors to complete the jury list of the County. On motion the number of Jurors to be drawn from the several townships, incorporated villages and cities, was apportioned as follows:

Newburgh 3, Norway 1, Westfield 2, Norman 2, Eger 3, Golden Lake 2, Higbland 2, Bergen 2, Primrose 2, Sherbrooke 2, Easton 1, Greenview 2, Eden-dale 1, Lincoln 1, Melrose 1, Riverside 1, Broadlawn 2, Colgate 2, Hope twp. 2, Willow Lake 1, Hope City 3, Finley Village 2.

F. E. Dibly, of the Fargo Bridge & Iron Co., appeared before the board and bridge business was discussed.

On motion the Fargo Bridge & Iron Co. was awarded the contract to build a new steel bridge on line between sections 11 and 12 Eger twp. for \$1800.00 as per plans submitted. Said bridge to be completed within 45 days. The resignation of Dr. M. C. Johnston, as Superintendent of the County Board of Health, was presented to the board and on motion accepted. On motion Dr. W. H. M. Philip was unanimously elected Superintendent of the County Board of Health for the balance of the year ending April 1st 1905, or until his successor is elected and qualified. On motion the following bills were allowed:
