

The threshing in this section of the state is about finished and the wheat yield was anywhere from 15 to 25 bushels per acre. This has certainly been a fine fall for threshing and has been one continual pound from the very start. We would venture to say that there has been more grain marketed up to this date this year than was marketed up to October 17th of last year. At present rain is badly needed for plowing operations.
