A GOOD PLANT.

The Hope electric light plant is now in first-class working order and we believe we have as good a plant as can be found in the state. The business portion of the city is lighted by seven large arc lights, while on every street corner thru-out the residence portion of the town, will be found a 50 candle power incandescent light, which lights our little city in such a manner that there is not a dark sidewalk in the whole town. The proposition prove a trifle more expensive perhaps than the old lighting system but there is one thing that can be said in favor of the new lights and that is, we have something we need not be ashamed of and when a stranger happens in town we can point with pride to our well lighted streets and business houses. The work of wiring the residences is being pushed as fast as possible and in a few weeks most every residence in the city will be lighted by electricity. Hope is certainly putting on metropolitan sirs. The next move that will bemade will be to connect Sherbrooke, Blabon, Colgate and a few more of the suburbs by an electric line.
