

Electric Lights

HOPE TO BE LIGHTED BY ELECTRICITY. GOOD PLANT WILL BE INSTALLED. CURRENT TO BE TURNED ON BY THE HOLIDAYS.

Arrangements have at last been completed whereby Hope is to have an electric light plant. The city council has been at work on the project for some time, and at the citizens' meeting held some time ago a committee was appointed to confer with C. S. Moores, of the Hope Roller Mills, and see what could be done and have him put in the plant and run it with the same power as is used in running the mill. Mr. Moores was asked to take the matter up and ascertain what would be required to make the plant a go and report to the committee, which he did. The committee at once set to work canvassing the town to find out what encouragement the citizens would give along this line of improvement. The committee met with far greater success than was even dreamed of. A citizens meeting was held Tuesday evening, in the council room, and it was decided to have Mr. Moores go on with the work of installing the plant, and the city would grant him a franchise. He expects to go below shortly and will purchase the plant, which will be the best that can be bought and if there are no delays in getting material he expects to have it installed and ready to turn on the current not later than the holidays. The city will put in a number of arc-lights and a sufficient number of smaller lights to light the city in firstclass shape. Let the good work go on.
