

Byron VandeBogart, who has been working on the Rhodes farm during the winter, died last Friday night after being sick for nearly three weeks with typhoid fever. He was the youngest son of W. S. VandeBogart, formerly a resident of this county, and was born nineteen years ago on the farm west of town where his parents lived at that time. His remains were taken to Zumbrota, Minn., on Wednesday's train for interment at which place the family have been living since leaving Griggs county.
