

Sudden Death.

Anton Anderson, the twelve year old son of Mr. and Mrs. Anton Anderson died a little after six o'clock Monday evening from heart failure and inflammation of the bowels brought on from an attack of typhoid-malaria. The little fellow was taken sick five days previous to his sickness it is thought through bathing in the slough up the railroad track and contracting the disease through carelessness. He was not considered dangerously ill until the morning previous to his death when the other complications set in and he failed rapidly. He was a bright little fellow and his loss is a severe blow to the family who have the sympathy of the community. The funeral was held yesterday afternoon at the Lutheran church, Rev. E. T. Silness officiating. The remains were interred in the cemetery at this place.
