

A SAD ACCIDENT.

**Express Messenger Morrissey's
-Leg Crushed to a Pulp.**

**Fully Two Hours Of Agony Be-
fore He Was Released.**

Express Messenger, P. Morrissey, on the H. B. Kingsley train met with a sad and painful accident on Tuesday, at Everest. He was sitting on the Pilot of the engine while the train crew were switching at Everest. The crew were attempting to couple a coach to the pilot of the engine, on coming together connections were missed and the pilot ran under the platform of the coach mashing his leg out of semblance between the pilot and the frame work of the platform. The breaks were set tight on the coach and it did not move. They were afraid to reverse the engine fearing further damage would be done to the boy. By the time the breaks were thrown off the coach and it had to be jacked and pinched away nearly two hours elapsed before the boy was released. Nearly another hour elapsed before three doctors arrived from Casselton. The leg was amputated first below the knee, the bones were found shattered and it was amputated about the knee. Young Morrissey is about 18 years old, his parents live at St. Paul. He does appear to take the matter very hard and on Wednesday he laid on his bed whistling.
