Sherbrooke, N. D., July 28, 1899.

Board of county commissioners convened at 10 o'clock a. m., pursuant to adjournment.

The application of Cyrus Skinner to purchase the interest of Steele county in lots 5, 6, 7 and 8, block 20, original townsite of Hope, and agreeing to pay for the same the sum of \$1250, was on motion accepted and the chairman directed to execute and the auditor to attest a quit claim deed of Steele county's interest in said lots to Cyrus Skinner.

Dr. A. Schreiber having removed from Steele county, his appointment as county physician for the north half of Steele county, was on motion revoked.

Dr. Charles E. Bennett of Aneta, was on motion appointed county physician for the northwest quarter of Steele county at a salary of \$90 per year, said salary to include medicine and medical attendance and to be paid quarterly.

On motion Dr. K. A. Wadel was appointed county physician for the northeast quarter of Steele county at a salary of \$100 per year, said salary to include medicine and medical attendance, to be paid quarterly, and to date from July 1, 1899.

The committee appointed to inspect site for grade between sections 13 and 24 Colgate, and 18 and 19 Broadlawn townships, reported as follows:

We, the committee appointed at the meeting of the board of July 11, 1899, to inspect grade sites between sections 13 and 24 Colgate, and 18 and 19 Broadlawn townships, for which an appropriation for aid had been petitioned, respectively submit the following report: We recommend that an appropriation of \$150 by the county toward the construction of said grade to be divided equally between Colgate and Broadlawn townships, said appropriation to be paid upon presentation to the board of county commissioners of the proper vouchers together with satisfactory proof that the grade has been completed.
