

# COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS.

## Official Proceedings of the Board of County Commissioners of Steele County.

Sherbrooke, N. D., Oct. 4, 1897.

Board of county commissioners convened in regular session at 10 o'clock a. m. Present R. B. Cochrane, chairman, and Commissioners King, Brown, Rindy and Williams.

The minutes of the meeting of August 16, 1897, were read and approved.

The school house on section 14, in Golden Lake precinct, having been recently moved to section 11 in said precinct, thereby removing the place designated as the polling place of said precinct; on motion it is hereby ordered that the polling place in the Golden Lake election precinct of Steele county, be, and the same is hereby changed from the school house on section 14 in said precinct, to the school house on section 11, as the polling place in said precinct.

In accordance with section 1,904, of the revised codes of 1895, on motion it was ordered that all county warrants which have remained uncalled for and on file for more than six years, be cancelled and destroyed as follows, viz:

On motion the Auditor was instructed to give notice of the sale of real property for delinquent taxes of 1896, by publication thereof once a week for three consecutive weeks during November 1897, in the Steele County Tribune, and offer said real estate for sale at public vendue the first Tuesday in December following, as provided by law.

On motion H. J. Rindy was appointed to inspect the Hollingstad bridge in Primrose township, when completed, and report the condition of the same to this board.

On motion the county auditor was instructed to secure the services of some one to plow a firebreak around the townsite, the county to bear one half the expense of plowing the same.
