Sherbrooke, N. D. October 5th, 1896.

Board of county commissioners met in regular session at 11 o'clock a. m. Present Chairman Rindy and Commissioners King, Williams, Cochrane and Brown.

ed drain commissioners.

On motion it was ordered that said

drain commissioners shall each receive

the sum of \$250 per day, for the time

actually spent by them in performing

the duties of their offices.

10 o'clock a. m., Saturday, November 7,

1896.
