The following resolution was upon motion adopted:

In accordance with chapter 91 of the session laws of 1891, it is hereby ordered that all noxious weeds mentioned in said law, found growing in the County of Steele, State of North Dakota, shall be destroyed in the following manner: either by pulling or any other method that may be effective in destroying the same. Said destruction to be performed between the 1st day of June and the 1st day of July 1894, and the county auditor is hereby instructed to mail a printed copy of this resolution on and said law to the township officers as provided in section two of said law.

The application of Louisa D F Hogue, for the purchase of the county's title to lot 1, block 22, original townsite of Hope, was granted and a quit claim deed for same ordered issued.

The official bonds of Henry F. Patten chairman Board of Supervisors of Lincoln township and J K Joslyn, chairman Board of supervisors of Melrose township were upon motion accepted and approved.
