

School Election.

The result of the school election held last Tuesday afternoon, for the purpose of voting on the question whether, the Incorporated Town be set off into an independent school district or remain as it is, resulted as follows: Incorporated Town of Hope, 27 for; 58 against. Hope township, 20 for; 2 against. This practically settles the school division question for the present at least. The result of the election was a surprise to many. Now the best thing to do is to bury the hatchet and come to some reasonable understanding in regard to school matters. We would suggest that we have three good district schools, if there are scholars enough in the district for that number, and for the benefit of the pupils who are advanced in their studies, that there be a buss run into town every night and morning for the accommodation of such scholars. This method has been in use in Broadlawn school district now for some time and, is said, to be working o. k. Think this matter over fellows, lets work for each others interests and thereby all benefit and save all this unpleasantness. There is no doubt, in our minds, if the matter is properly handled but what some satisfactory arrangement can be made.
