Owing to the crowded condition of the Hope Public Schools no more students will be admitted in any grade after Monday, Jan. 12th, 1903, until the opening of the spring term, and no special classes will be formed for delinquent students. Children under six years of age are excluded by law, and teachers will be justified in refusing to enroll them. The course of study and classification of students is entrusted entirely to the principal of the schools. Parents are respectfully requested to send their children to school in a cleanly condition.
