

NOTICE OF SALE OF SCHOOL HOUSES.

By a majority vote of the citizens of Broadlawn township at a special election held at the District Clerk's office Saturday, July 25th, 1903 it was decided to sell the four small school houses in said town. The school houses known and designated as No. 2, No. 3, No. 4, and No. 5, and located as follows: No. 2 on sw corner of Sec. 4; No. 3 on ne corner of Sec. 11; No. 4 on se corner of Sec. 29; No. 5 on nw corner of Sec. 25; and out buildings; All in township number 144, Range 54 Steele County, North Dakota.

Now therefore in conformity with said vote we, the Directors of Broadlawn school township, at a meeting held this 1st day of August 1903 upon motion decided to offer the above enumerated property for sale upon the following terms and conditions:
