There was a fatal wreck on the G. N. at Blanchard, last Friday night. Two persons were killed outright and the third has died since and a number of passengers were seriously injured

Engineer Martin and Fireman Davis, who make the run up this branch, on their arrival at Casselton that evening, was ordered to couple onto the through freight and assist them to Larimore. The way treight was headed north and was on the main track waiting for orders, when the through freight reached Blanchard. Owing to the severe storm the aignallights were rendered invisible and as a result the through freight crashed into the rear of the way freight, which was standing on the main track waiting for orders.

Firemen Davis, and two traveling men, who were in the coach
attached to the rear of the way
freight, whose names we were
unable to learn, were killed. N.
D. Balley, a traveling man and
Engineer Martin were both badly injured, but it is thought will
not prove tatal.

The through freight was a double header and was funning at a high rate of speed when it struck.
