DIED:-At the home of William Aldrich in this city, on Monday, Mar. 18th, at 10:15 p. m. Mrs. Julia E. Drakely, at the advanced age of 80 years, 8 months and 25 days. Deceased was born on June 23d, 1820 in the state of Ohio, where the early years of her life were spent.
