

DIED

At her home in Edendale township, on Sunday, April 23, 1905, at 10 o'clock a. m., Mrs. Hannah Mooté, wife of Mr. Arthur Mooté, after a lingering illness from that dread disease, consumption. Aged 38 years, 1 month and 29 days.

The subject of this brief sketch was a native of Stai, Norway, and came to this country in the early 80's, and for a number of years thereafter resided with her brothers and sisters who lived near Cooperstown, N. D. She was born February 22, 1867, making her a little over 38 years of age at the time of her death. Her maiden name was Miss Hannah Stai.

The 25th of May, '95, she was united in marriage to Mr. Arthur Mooté, and to this union five children were born—four boys and one girl—the eldest nine years of age, the youngest being but a babe of about eight months, who will sadly miss the tender care of a loving and affectionate mother.

Besides her children deceased leaves a husband, four sisters and two brothers to mourn her loss. Three of her sisters, one brother, three nieces and one nephew were here to attend the funeral and pay their respects to the memory of the departed loved one.

Funeral services were held amid the floral Easter decorations at the M. E. church Tuesday afternoon, Presiding Elder Rev. M. C. Burns, officiating, and the remains laid to rest in the Hope cemetery south of town, followed there by a large concourse of sorrowing relatives and friends.
