

Official Proceedings

Of The Board of County Commissioners.

Sherbrooke, N. D., April 14th 06.

The Board of County Commissioners met in special session at 9 o'clock A. M. pursuant to call of the County Auditor. Present K. S. Sulland, F. Gray, G O Johnson and K A Johnson. Minutes of the meeting of April 2nd 06, read and on motion approved.

The committees appointed to inspect bridge and grade sites, made the following reports:

We recommend that the Township Board of Riverside twp. lay out road on quarter line in section 32 Riverside twp. and that the county make an appropriation sufficient to pay the owners of the land any reasonable amount of damage in securing the right-of-way for said road:

That a 24ft bridge be built, this season, on line between sections 26 and 35 Carpenter twp. This petition asking for an appropriation of \$300.00 to grade approaches to bridge on line between sections 35 and 36 Carpenter twp be granted.

We recommend that the bridge on quarter line in section 10 Enger twp. be repaired by driving 16 cedar piling, not less than 32 ft in length, the two center rows to be sway braced. That the bridge on line between sections 26 and 27 Enger twp. be replanked and repaired by putting in four new steel joists 4x7, 22ft 4 inches in length; the lumber for replanking said bridge to be furnished by the county, delivered at Hatton or Portland, and the same to be hauled and laid by and at the expense of the Township. That petition for a bridge on line between sections 25 and 26 Enger twp. be laid on the table.

The petition for an appropriation of \$200.00 for grading on line between sections 19 and 20 Willow Lake twp. was on motion laid on the table.
