The Board of County Commissioners convened at 9 o'clock a. m., pursuant to call of the County Auditor. All members present.

Minutes of the meeting of April 3rd, 1905, read and on motion approved.

The committees appointed to inspect bridge and grade sites reported as follows:

We, the committee appointed to inspect site for grading on line between sections 23, 24 and 24, 13, Sharon twp., recommend that an appropriation of \$250.00 be made. We recommend that an appropriation of \$25.00 be made to assist in rebuilding bridge on line between sections 34 and 35, Westfield twp., and recommend that the petition for an appropriation of \$200.00 to rebuild bridge on line between sections 17 and 20, Westfield twp., be laid on the table.

The Fargo Bridge & Iron Co. having submitted bid and plans for building a 60 ft. cedar pile bridge, on line between sections 15 and 22, Broadlawn twp. It was on motion ordered that the contract for building said bridge be awarded The Fargo Bridge & Iron Co. at \$600.00.

The Coroner's report in the matter of an Inquisition held upon the dead body of Anna K. Nygaard, was on motion approved and Coroner fees amounting to \$3.50 ordered paid; said fees having been collected and turned over to the County Treasurer.

The reports of the States Attorney of investigations as to violation of the prohibition law was on motion and approved and witness fees, to be paid from the liquor prosecution fund, allowed as follows: Investigation at Hope—E.
