On motion the valuation of sleighs and sleds was placed at \$5 00 each and increased and decreased in the various assessment districts by the following per centum: Increased, Newburg 20 per cent; Norway 112 per cent; Norman 20 per cent; Enger 35 $\frac{1}{2}$ per cent; Golden Lake 73 per cent; Highland 10 per cent; Bergen 5 per cent; Easton 7 per cent; Lincoln 55 per cent; Riverside 25 per cent; Decreased, Greenview 3 per cent, Edendale 5 per cent; Willow Lake 16 $\frac{1}{2}$ per cent; Finley Village 20 per cent; no change made in Westfield, Primrose, Broadlawn and Hope twp.

On motion the value of bicycles was placed at \$7 25 and increased and decreased in the several assessment districts by the following per centum: Increased, Easton 25 per cent, Hope City 7 per cent. Decreased, Edendale 37 $\frac{1}{2}$ per cent, Willow Lake 37 $\frac{1}{2}$ per cent.

On motion the valuation of wagons, carriages and other wheeled vehicles was placed at \$12 00 and increased and decreased in the several assessment districts by the following per centum: Increased; Newburgh 33 $\frac{1}{2}$ per cent, Norman 15 per cent, Golden Lake 87 per cent, Highland 90 per cent, Bergen 88 per cent, Primrose 4 per cent, Easton 10 per cent, Edendale 4 per cent, Lincoln 44 per cent, Melrose 2 per cent, Broadlawn 16 per cent, Willow Lake 6 per cent. The value of melodians, organs and other musical instruments was on motion fixed at \$12 00 and increased and decreased in the several assessment districts by the following per centum: Increased: Westfield 7 per cent, Enger 140 per cent, Golden Lake 83 $\frac{1}{2}$ per cent, Highland 45 per cent, Bergen 152 per cent, Primrose 4 per cent, Sherbrooke 45 per cent, Easton 4 per cent, Lincoln 141 per cent, Melrose 20 per cent, Broadlawn 11 per cent, Hope twp 28 per cent, Willow Lake 48 per cent.
