On motion the board adjourned until 1:30 P. M. same day.

AFTERNOON SESSION.

The County board of Review and equalization convened at 1:30 P. M. pursuant to adjournment. All members present.

For the purpose of equalizing the value of horses one year old was on motion fixed at \$13.00, and increased and decreased in the several assessment districts by the following per centum. Increased Newburgh 8 per cent; Norway 12 per cent; Eger 32 per cent; Highland 8 per cent; Bergen 55 per cent; Primrose 38 per cent Edendale 30 per cent; Colgate 70 per cent; Hope Twp. 1 per cent; Hope City 10 per cent; Decreased Westfield 1 per cent Norman 13 per cent; Sherbrooke 15 per cent; Greenview 19 per cent; Lincoln 11 per cent Melrose 11 per cent; Riverside 13 per cent; Broadlawn 13 per cent Willow Lake 12 per cent; Finley Village 1 per cent; No change made in Easton.
