

COUNCIL DOINGS

Regular meeting of City Council Monday evening June 1st 1908.

Present Mayor Warner and Aldermen, Hanley, Ehred, Major, Fisher and Roney.

Minutes of last regular and subsequent special meetings read and approved. Moved by Ehred and seconded by Fisher that City Auditor draw warrants to the foremen of different fire companies for their attendance at last fire, carried. The bill of Chas. Ferrel for work on road \$3.60 was on motion duly allowed and warrant ordered drawn for same. The following report of committee appointed to inspect the water supply for fire purposes was then read:

We, the undersigned committee, appointed by the president of the City Council of Hope, to inspect and repair cisterns for water supply for fire purposes, found cisterns full of water and in good shape as follows:

Cistern on north side of block 25 on Kidder avenue in good shape. Cistern at corner of Hubbard and 5th st. full of water and alright except a little repair on the cover.

Cistern at Corner of Ingalls and 4th st. has no water in it. We recommend a brick arch and iron cover for it.

Cistern on 2nd st. east side of block 30 leaky and hard to repair.

Cistern on 2nd st. on west side of block 24 should be enlarged so as to hold 500 bbls.

Cistern on Steele avenue, in front of McLaughlin's office full of water and in good shape for this year.

Cistern at town hall in good shape and full of water.

Moved by Hanley, seconded by Ehred that we have cisterns repaired on 2nd st., corner Ingalls and 4th st. and Hubbard and 5th st. carried.
