FOUND STRYCHNINE.

It will be remembered that at the time of the inquest in the case of Miss Jerdis Holt some weeks since, the assistant of Prof. E. F. Ladd at Fargo, reported that he found no traces of strychnia in the stomach analysis made by him, in the case. It seems that States Attorney Johnson desired to find out more definitely in regard to the matter and so made a request for analysis which Prof. Ladd made in person finding that further in the stomach than the place where the walls were removed for the first analysis, by making test there was sufficient material found to give a fairly good reaction for the presence of strychnia and there was present strychnia in the stomach walls. The error made by the assistant was due to a portion of the contents of the stomach being lost and did not remove the walls far enough to remove the strychnia.-Sherbrooke Tribune.
