On motion the lots in block 6 Sherbrooke village was withdrawn and not offered for sale.

On motion the board adjourned until 1:30 p. m. same day.

AFTERNOON SESSION.

The board of county commissioners reconvened at 1:30 p. m. All members present. The various bids made on the town lots was considered and on motion duly seconded and carried, all members voting aye, the bids made for the west 25 ft. of east 70½ ft. lots 1 and 2, block 23 Hope, and the west 22 ft. of east 45½ ft. of lots 1 and 2, block 23 Hope, also for lots 1 to 24 inclusive, block 14 Sherbrooke, was rejected; the highest bids for all the other lots were approved and accepted; the auditor instructed to prepare proper form of deeds and to have all other tax claims, if any, held by Steele county against the lots sold, satisfied.

On motion made, seconded and carried, the west 25 ft. of east 70½ ft. of lots 1 and 2 block 23 Hope, was leased to Geo. A. Warner for the period of 7 years at the rate of \$12.00 per year, and the west 22 ft. of the east 45½ ft. of lots 1 and 2 block 23 Hope, leased to C. S. Shippy for the same period and rate per year.

The petition for two bridges on line between sections 33 Westfield township and section 4 Finley, was on motion tabled, and it was decided that a 26 ft. I beam bridge be built on line between sections 33 and 34 Westfield.

The petition for a bridge on line between sections 6 and 7 Carpenter twp., was on motion granted and an appropriation of \$100.00 granted to assist the township in building stone abutments for said bridge.

The petition for an appropriation for \$500.00 for grading road on line between sections 24 and 25 Easton twp. was on motion granted at \$300.00.

The petition for an appropriation for grading on line between sections 12 and 13 and 11 and 14 Finley twp. was on motion tabled.

A petition was presented asking for an appropriation for grading on line between sections 7 and 8 and 17 and 20 Sharon township and on motion the chairman appointed O. N. Grefsheim, J. B. Oxtan and Frank Gray as a committee to inspect the site.

The petition for an appropriation of \$400.00 for grading on line between sections 15 and 16 and 21 and 22 and 27 and 28 Westfield twp. was on motion tabled.

K. S. Sulland presented treasurers receipt for \$5.00 for old bridge lumber sold.
