
Bismarcker Found Dead.

Bismarck, April 8.—Edward M. Bidwell, clerk in the landoffice here, was found dead this morning beside the railroad track in this city. His head was crushed and he was badly injured about the body. It is supposed he fell from a train at midnight while returning from Mandan. His body was found by the crew of a freight train several hours later. He was a Knight Templar and a Shriner, and well known and popular in the city. He is a nephew of E. W. Blackwell of the Gull River Lumber Co., of Cooperstown. A coroner's inquest is being held today to ascertain the manner of death.
