

Joseph Dusbabek was accidentally shot by Henry Harmson July 4th, and died from the wounds received a few hours afterwards. Dusbabek was in act of throwing an old hat into the air for Harmson to shoot at and the gun was accidentally discharged, the victim receiving the charge in the right arm and abdomen which was completely riddled by shot. The accident occurred on the Harmson farm a mile and a half west of Binford. Dr. Brimi was sent for but could do no good other than relieve the poor fellow's sufferings. States Attorney Tufte and Sheriff Thinglestad drove out to investigate and Dusbabek stated to them that the affair was an accident. Deceased was about 20 years old.
