

DIED—on Saturday morning at 12:30 a. m. Mrs. Rozina Adams, mother of Messrs. George, Charley and William Adams of this city. The deceased was taken to St. John's Hospital of Fargo last week and was operated upon for the removal of gall stones last Tuesday morning and died from the effects of the operation as stated above. The deceased was 64 years old last October. She was born near Royal Oaks, Mich., in 1840 and was married in 1860. Her husband died in 1876 leaving his widow and three sons. The family moved to Wisconsin in 1874 and then to Folk county, S. Dak., in 1883 thence to Griggs county in the fall of 1898. There were only three children in the family, all boys, George, Charley and Will, all of whom survive their parents. The many friends of the Adams family sympathize with them in the loss of their mother. The funeral occurred at the Baptist church, last Monday afternoon, Rev. S. Bachelor officiating, interment being made in the Cooperstown cemetery.
