

Death of Mrs. Hadlock.

Mrs. Eliza Ann Hadlock, mother of William and Reese Hadlock and Mrs. H. A. Bemis of this county and of Mrs. Wright and Mrs. Wilson. of Barnes county, died at Valley City Sunday morning last.
