Mrs. Rudquist, an aged lady living with her son-in-law, Gust Jorstad, was found drowned in s the Sheyenne river near the t Romness M. E. church last Fri day evening. She left home in the morning and wandered around all day in the woods. She was seen by Ole Auseth in the afternoon and he asked her what she wanted. She replied that she wanted to go through his pasture to John Hogenson's and he told her he was going there and that she could go along with him but she refused to do so and he left her there, and the next he heard of her was when her body was discovered in the river. The poor woman had evidently been brooding over something and took her own life. The officials did not think an inquest was necessary and the remains were taken care of and buried by friends.
