

Acting upon the suggestion of the local papers the cemetery association passed around a subscription paper and raised something over \$200 in cash and have let the contract for building a tool house and waiting room at the cemetery, which will be equipped with all the necessary tools and also a stove so that on wet or cold days workmen or those out at the cemetery will have a place to get in from the weather. Outbuildings are also being built on the grounds, a well is being dug and a tank holding eleven barrels of water will be put out there for watering trees and plants. Contractor Moffatt is now at work putting up the buildings. The association is trying to hire a man to take care of the cemetery by the year and the grounds will be cleaned up and those who have graves out there can get them taken care of for a reasonable sum. These are steps in the right direction and The Courier is pleased that the citizens and officials of the association have taken hold of the matter in such a business-like manner.
