

THE CITY COUNCIL

The city council met in regular session Monday night with Mayor Bergin in the chair. The alderman present were Greenland, Houghton, Marquardt and Trubshaw.

Minutes of previous meeting were read and approved.

Two bids were submitted for doing cement work for the city, one from Edland Bros. of Hannaford and one from J. A. Moffatt of this city. The council considered the bids too high and rejected both and will ask for new bids to be submitted next Monday night.

A number of bills were presented and duly allowed.

Complaint had been made to the annoyance caused by children roller skating on the sidewalks and the chief of police was instructed to regulate this matter as he saw fit.

A petition signed by the business men of the city asking for the appointment of a night policeman was presented to the council. It was voted to grant the petition and the mayor will consider the appointment of a man for the position.

The city auditor and chief of police were instructed to notify the railroad company to clean up their stock yards.

Sidewalks and crossings were ordered in, in the various parts of the town and the council adjourned.
