

The city council met Monday evening, it being the regular meeting. The King-Bruns Co. made application for the purchase of a piece of ground 33x42 on the rear end of their business block. After considering the matter the council decided to sell them a piece of ground 33x40, thus reserving a full lot on the town property. The price voted upon by the council for this piece of ground was \$250. The auto company will build an addition to their present building. The council also passed a resolution to have an ordinance drawn up regulating the placing of boxes, machinery and other obstructions on the sidewalks and streets of the city. The usual bills were allowed and the council adjourned.
