

AN ORDINANCE

To prevent the obstruction of sidewalks.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cooperstown.

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to put, keep or place any box, vehicle or other obstruction upon the sidewalks of the City of Cooperstown.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to place any awning, signs or other obstruction across and over the sidewalks of the City of Cooperstown less than 7 feet in the clear above the same.

Section 3. Any person, firm or corporation violating any or either of the foregoing provisions upon conviction thereof shall be liable to a fine not to exceed ten dollars for each and every day said obstruction is allowed to exist.

This ordinance shall be in force from and after its passage and publication.
