

NEW RURAL ROUTE

**Postmaster Trubshaw Instructed
to Start Route No. 3
on April 1.**

After waiting patiently for many months the government has at last granted the petition of the farmers for a third rural route at Cooperstown and the same will be established on April first. Before the service can be placed in operation it will be necessary for the patrons of this proposed route to put up approved mail boxes and leave with the postmaster the names of those who are to receive mail in the box placed at each farm. The postmaster at Cooperstown is now ready to receive applications from any person who desire to carry the mail. Particulars can be had by calling at the postoffice. The new route will run as follows: Starting at the postoffice at Cooperstown thence: West to east line sec. 23, $\frac{1}{2}$ miles, North to S. W. cor. sec. 12, 1 3-4; West to S. W. cor. sec. 11, 1 mile; North to S. W. cor. sec. 23, 4 m; West 1, south 1, west 1, 3 m; South to S. W. cor. sec. 4, 2 m; West 1, south 1, west 1, 3 m; South to S. W. cor. sec. 19, 2 m; West to S. W. cor. sec 24, 1 m; South to S. W. cor. sec. 1 3 m; East to S. W. cor., sec, 5, 2 m; North to S. W. cor. Sec. 20, 3 m; East to S. E. cor. sec. 24, 4 m; North 1-4, and east $\frac{1}{2}$ to P. O. 3-4 m
Length of route, 31 miles.
