A motion was made, seconded and carried, ordering that the following sums be raised by a levy on all taxable property in the county

For general fund \$19,000.
For bridge fund \$5,500.
For sinking fund \$1,800.
For interest fund \$1,800.
For insane hospital fund \$1,500.

Also that a tax of five-tenths of a mill be levied on all the taxable property of the county for an emergency fund, and that a tax of two-tenths of a mill be levied on all the taxable property of the county for the benefit of the Griggs County Fair Association.

On motion the board adjourned until 9 o'clock a. m. July 11th.

The board convened pursuant to adjournment with the same commissioners present.

On motion Chairman Blackwell and County Surveyor Ueland were appointed a committee to examine, when completed, the two bridges which are being built and if found satisfactory, to accept for the county.

The petition in regard to the grade between section 13 Broadview township and section 18 Willow Lake township, Steele county, was again considered and on motion, the board agreed to aid the work to the extent of one-half its cost provided the total cost is not more than \$500.

The following resolution was passed by the board:

Whereas, a number of property owners in the county have represented to members of the board that the question of abolishing the herd law contained in Art. 9 Chapter 24 Revised Code of 1905, should be submitted to the voters, and desiring to provide for such vote at the next general election. Therefore, be it resolved by the board of county commissioners of Griggs county that the provisions of said Article 9, in regard to stock running at large, are abolished within said county, and a vote on such question is hereby ordered to be taken, according to the provisions of law, at the next general election.
