The County Supt. of Highways recommended the payment to B. N. Howden of \$140.00 as part payment on grading contract between Helena and Clearfield townships. This was, on motion, approved by the Board and an auditor's warrant was ordered drawn for the amount.

Auditor's warrant No. 3696 having been issued in favor of E. W. Blackwell for \$100.00, the amount having been used in aid to the poor sick, the action was, on motion, approved.

The Supt. of Highways recommended the payment to Gust Arneson of \$50.00 as part payment on road grading done by him on town line between Romness and Tyrol town-

ships. The same was, on motion, approved by the board, and an auditor's warrant ordered drawn for amount.

The 1910 taxes on Lot 10 Block 79, city of Cooperstown, were on motion, ordered refunded to W. A. Adams on a valuation of \$90, for the reason that there was a clerical error in the assessment figures of that amount.

On motion John G. Mills was appointed an appraiser for an estray taken up by Endre Aarestad in Ball Hill township.

On motion, Ole P. Overby was appointed an appraiser for two estray colts taken up by Edw. Johnson in Romness township.

The quarterly justice report of H. S. Rearick was presented. In order to comply with the law the following changes were made in the items due the sheriff for automobile livery expenses:
