

# INSTITUTE ON WHEELS



Northern Pacific will Run Special Train June 12-28. Will be at Cooperstown June 27.



The Northern Pacific in conjunction with the North Dakota Agricultural College, will run a special Farmers' Institute train leaving Fargo June 12, being enroute 16 days and making stops at 42 towns. The train will consist of cars with exhibits, horses, a coach for dairy and exhibits of poultry, sheep, swine, cattle, horses, a coach for dairy and veterinary exhibits, also separate coaches for the study of soils, good seed, chemistry, horticulture and home economics. In all there will be 22 lecturers, and representatives of the Farmers' Institute accompanying the train under the direction of T. A. Hoverstad. Officials of the Northern Pacific will be with the train. The schedule for the Cooperstown branch is as follows:
