

Nels Lunde barely missed serious injury from the accidental discharge of a shotgun last Sunday while out hunting with Theo. Kittelson and others.. Mr. Kittelson had put two shells in his gun and then "broke" the gun and carried it in this condition. After a time they suddenly ran into a covey of chickens and the gun was snapped together ready for business and all jumped out of the rig and the gun was accidentally discharged at the same time and Mr. Lunde being within range received the discharge in the upper part of the leg above the knee, the shot plowing a ridge about a quarter of an inch deep. He was brought back home and it was necessary to take some stitches to bring the wound together and for a few days he will have a stiff leg. It was certainly a very lucky escape form serious injury and Mr. Lunde as well as those with him are greatly relieved to think that it was no worse.
