Board met pursuant to adjournment this 25th day of July 1905.

All members present.

Minutes of the proceeding meeting read and approved.

On motion the following bills were allowed:

Grand Forks Herald, blanks.....\$14 50

H. S. Rearick, publishing..... 48 95

C. J. Lucken, mdse. for dipping tank at Binford..... 4 00

Fargo Heating & Plumbing Co., mdse. for court house..... 18 00

On motion, the following auditor's warrant was approved: No. 1816 for \$158.00 in favor of Jorgon Soma, payment for grading between Sec. 7-145-58 and Sec. 12-145-59.

On motion it was ordered that the following school poll tax for 1904 be refunded from the town of Romoes. Account assessed and paid in two districts.

P. P. Idavoog, \$1.00.

A motion was made, seconded and un-animously carried that a tax of one-fifth of one mill on each one dollars valuation be levied on all the real and personal property assessed in the county in the year 1905.

The bond of the First National Bank of Hannaford was received by the Board and by resolution approved; the county auditor being directed to return to the First National Bank of Hannaford, the bonds of the Hannaford State Bank and the Griggs County State Bank.

Commissioner Johnson was, by motion, authorized to sell, to best advantage, the old bridge material now at Ottawa bridge.

The board proceeded to check the accounts of the auditor and treasurer.

On motion board adjourned until 8:30 a. m., July 26th.

Board met as per adjournment, with all members present, and completed the check of the auditor's and treasurer's office, found correct.

On motion Commissioners Nelson and Hadlock were appointed a committee to inspect, and accept for the county, the bridge which is to be built in Bald Hill township.

On Motion Commissioners Gunderson and Johnson were appointed a committee to inspect and accept for the county the bridges which are to be built in Tyrol township and in the second District.

T. O. Hetager was, by motion, instructed to rebuild and rearrange the shelves in the vault of the auditor's office.

On motion board adjourned, sine die.
