

Death of Clara Hogenson.

Miss Clara Hogenson, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. John Hogenson of Romness township, died at her home last Sunday morning from typhoid fever, after a sickness which lasted nearly two months. She was 26 years old. Miss Hogenson was formerly bookkeeper for C. T. Whidden and went to Tolna about three months ago and was taken sick shortly after she went there. The funeral was held in the Romness church last Tuesday afternoon and the remains were laid to rest in the cemetery at that place.
