

The following from the Lisbon Free Press will interest our readers: Died at Hartford, Conn., on Oct. 11, 1910, after an operation, Charles Stermer, a former member, and for several years quartermaster sergeant of the North Dakota Soldiers' Home. Sergeant Stermer had a record of four year's service in the civil war having been first sergeant of Co. A, 1st Connecticut heavy artillery, which was one of the few heavy artillery regiments that went into active field service in the early part of the war and participated in all of the campaigns of the army of the Potomac from the Peninsula in 1862 to Appomattox in 1865. Mr. Stermer had a host of friends in Lisbon who are sorry to hear of his death.
