

Carl William Arndt died at his home near Jessie last Friday morning, June 11, from heart failure. The deceased had been in poor health for the past two years but was not considered in a dangerously sick condition. He was found dead in bed. Mr. Arndt was seventy-four years old and was one of the early settlers in Griggs county, coming here in 1882. His wife died some years ago. He leaves two daughters, Mrs. Charley Schrieter, of Sanborn and Mrs. Emily Bishoff, of West Superior, Wis., and four sons, William, Charley, Adolph and Frank. The funeral was held last Sunday, Rev. J. L. Bohnhoff of Valley City, conducting the services. Interment was made in the Cooperstown cemetery.
