

MRS. KINGSLEY DEAD

Prominent Old Settler of Griggs
County Passed Away Tuesday
Morning.

Word was received from Valley City Tuesday morning conveying the sad news of the death of Mrs. Harriet Kingsley, widow of the late William Kingsley, which occurred at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Frank Sanford, of Valley City Tuesday morning. Mrs. Kingsley was apparently in her usual health. On Tuesday morning she went into the bath room and without any warning crumpled down in an unconscious condition. She died about three hours afterwards. The deceased was one of the pioneer citizens of the county coming here with her husband in 1883. She was a much respected lady and many friends all over the county will regret to hear of her passing away. She was 76 years old at the time of her death. Her husband died several years ago. Mrs. Kingsley was the mother of Mrs. Frank Sanford, of Valley City, Mrs. J. W. Wilsie, Mrs. John E. Sutton and Frank Kingsley of this county, all four of them surviving their parents.
