

## D. McDANIEL DEAD.

The following obituary from the Iola, Kansas Daily Register, will be of interest to the many friends of the McDaniel family in this county:

D. D. McDaniel was born in Davis county, Iowa, in 1854, and moved to Illinois with his parents when eight years of age. In 1876 he came to Colony, Kansas, in which city on March 30th, 1881, he was married to Miss Mirtle Whitaker, of near Carlyle. Of this union one child was born on April 20th, 1882. Within the lapse of a little more than a year both mother and child died and were laid to rest in Iola cemetery. Shortly afterwards Mr. McDaniel returned to Illinois where he remained slightly more than a year, and then went to North Dakota, where he farmed for sixteen years. In 1888 while on a visit to his father and mother he confessed his faith in Christ and became united with the Christian church, continuing as a member up to the time of his death. In 1889 he met and married Miss Mable Dine in North Dakota. In 1900 they moved to Illinois. In 1905 they traveled by wagon through Missouri, Kansas, Oklahoma, Southeastern Colorado, New Mexico and Texas, for the benefit of Mr. McDaniels' health. As his condition, after three years of travel, did not seem to improve, he decided to return to Iola. He died on February 8th, 1911, his age being fifty-six years, eight months and twenty-one days. He is survived by a wife, two brothers, two sisters and many other relatives and friends.
